Last year's global day of rallies on October 24th turned out to "the most widespread day of political action in the planet's history," according to CNN, with 5200 actions in 181 countries. And, in Copenhagen, that translated into 117 countries--most of the world's nations--supporting a tough 350 target. But many of the biggest polluters didn't sign on, so activists around the world are joining forces on 10/10/10 in a day of rallies and work parties to pressure politicians to pass legislation and sign the treaty that will help to confront the global climate crisis - in time.

This year, the Unitarian Universalist Congregation of the South Jersey Shore is hosting a Green Building Tour as part of the global effort to support climate change solutions.
