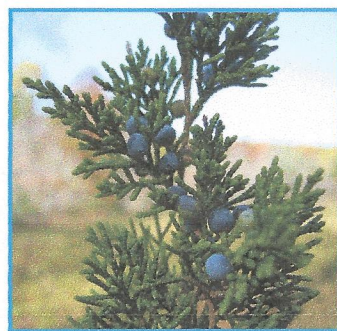
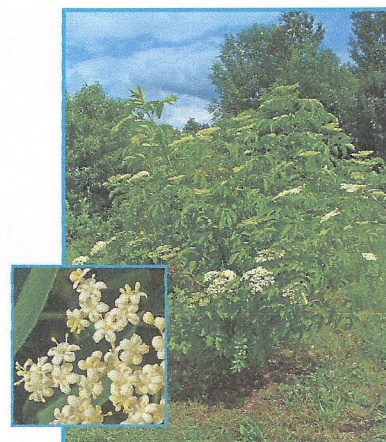

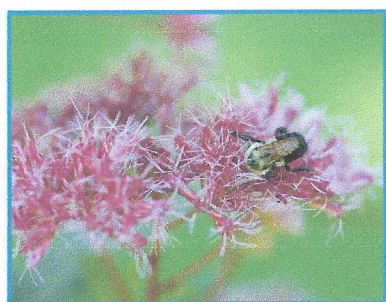
Red cedar
